The new Moultrie Middle School is located on the same site where the previous Moultrie Middle School existed as well as where the old Moultrie High School once stood. The new facility will accommodate 900 6th, 7th, and 8th graders with a core facility to accommodate 1200, allowing for future expansion of the facility. The school has been laid out and master planned for these future additions to be added on to each of the three classroom wings. The exterior front architectural design of this facility was designed to pay homage to the old Moultrie High School. This facility is also a key part of the Town of Mt. Pleasant's Coleman Boulevard Revitalization Project.

The 125,000 square foot facility will have 31 teaching stations with nine science labs as well as several resource rooms, art rooms, band and music labs. The facility will also contain a state-of-the-art Media Center located on the second floor overlooking Coleman Boulevard, as well as a full-size gymnasium. The facility has also been designed as a community friendly school where the Media Center, Cafeteria, and Gymnasium are located for accessibility for after hours activities without having to access classroom corridors.

The new facility has also been designed and constructed under the U.S. Green Building Council LEED program initiatives; however, CCSD did not seek certification due to the costs associated with certification.

A unique aspect of this facility is a collaboration with the Town of Mt. Pleasant. Charleston County School District has entered into a joint-use agreement with the Town of Mt. Pleasant which allowed the Town to construct the recently opened Farmer's Market and will also be used by the school as an outdoor learning classroom. The Town will also construct a "pocket park" off Coleman Boulevard. This collaboration also included the Town's use of the athletic fields of the school.
